NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' Gazetted post of "Senior Environmental Engineer" in the Department of Science, Technology and Environment, Puducherry, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (i) These rules may be called the Government of Puducherry, Department of Science, Technology and Environment, Group 'A' post of Senior Environmental Engineer Recruitment Rules, 2017.

(ii) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number of post, its classification and Level in the Pay Matrix.*— The number of the said post, its classification and the Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications, etc.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualifications.*— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry, is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission and for the reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Savings.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

SCHEDULE

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF SENIOR ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEER

1. Name of the post : Senior Environmental Engineer
2. Number of post : 1 (One) [2017] Subject to variation dependent on work-load.
3. Classification : General Central Services - Group - 'A' Gazetted – Non-Ministerial.
4. Level in the Pay Matrix : Level - 11
5. Whether selection post or non-selection post : Not Applicable
6. Age-limit for direct recruits : Not Applicable
7. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits : Not Applicable
8. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees. : Not Applicable
9. Period of probation, if any : Two years for Promotees
10. Method of recruitment, whether by direct recruitment or by promotion or by deputation/absorption and percentage of the vacancies to be filled by various methods. : By Deputation (Including Short Term Contract)/Promotion
11. In case of recruitment by promotion /deputation/ absorption, grades from which promotion/deputation/absorption is to be made. : **Deputation (ISTC)/Promotion**
Officers under the Central Government/State Governments/ Union Territories/Recognised Research Institutions/ Universities/Public Sector undertakings/Semi-Government/ Statutory or Autonomous Organizations :-
- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on a regular basis in the parent cadre/department; or
- (ii) with 5 years service rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in Level-10 in the Pay Matrix or equivalent; or
- (iii) with 6 years service rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in Level-8 in the Pay Matrix or equivalent; or
- (iv) with 7 years service rendered after appointment thereto on a regular basis in posts in Level-7 in the Pay Matrix or equivalent; and
- (b) possessing the Educational qualifications and experience as below:-
- Essential**
- (i) Master's Degree in Environmental Engineering/ Technology or Chemical Engineering from a Recognized University with 2 years of experience in Environmental Quality Management and Pollution Control activities.

(or)

Bachelors Degree in Environmental Engineering/Technology or Chemical Engineering from a Recognized University with 5 years of experience in Environmental Quality Management and Pollution Control activities.

[The Departmental Environmental Engineer in Level-7, in the Pay Matrix with 7 years regular service rendered in the grade after appointment thereto on a regular basis and having the educational qualifications as above will also be considered along with the outsiders. If, the departmental candidate is selected for appointment to the post, the post shall be treated as having been filled by promotion].

Note : (1) Period of deputation (ISTC) including the period of deputation (ISTC) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organization or Departments of the Central/ State/Union Territory Governments shall ordinarily not exceed 4 years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note : (2) The Departmental Officers in the feeder grade who are in direct line of promotion will not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.
