## THE APPROPRIATION BILL, 2018

(Bill No. 1 of 2018)

A

BILL

**to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Puducherry for the services in respect of the period from 1-4-2017 to 31-3-2018.**

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Puducherry in the Sixty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation Act, 2018.

Supplementary appropriation of ₹ 644,01,06,000 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Puducherry for the period from 1-4-2017 to 31-3-2018.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Puducherry, there may be paid and applied further sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Six hundred forty- four crores, One lakh and six thousand rupees, towards defraying the several charges which will come in the course of payment during the period from 1-4-2017 to 31-3-2018 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Puducherry by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of  
Puducherry in the Sixty-ninth Year of the Republic  
of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2018. Short title.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Puducherry, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column (5) of the Schedule, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of Two thousand four hundred forty-six crore sixty-six lakhs and sixty-seven thousand rupees, towards "Vote on Account" for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the months of April, May, June and July 2018 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule. Vote on Account for ₹ 2446,66,67,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Puducherry for the months of April, May, June and July 2018.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the Union territory of Puducherry by this Act, shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period. Appropriation.
