ORDER

Whereas, an inquiry under rule 14 of the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1965, has been conducted against Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, Circle-II, Public Works Department, Puducherry, against the complaint of unauthorized absence and absconding from duty, without the sanction of the competent authority.

And whereas, a charge-sheet, dated 02-07-2018 along with statement of articles of charges and imputation of misconduct or misbehaviour had been issued to Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, directing him to furnish his statement of defence.

And whereas, Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, had received the charge-sheet sent to his residence and acknowledged the receipt of the same *vide* Acknowledgment, dated 04-07-2018 of the Postal Department.

And whereas, Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, has not submitted his written statement of defence on or before the date specified in Para-2 of the charge-sheet Memo. No. 9309/PW/SE-II/E6/2018/694, dated 02-07-2018, but, appeared in person before the undersigned on the forenoon of 16-07-2018 and uttered his apology towards the inconvenience caused through unauthorized absence. During the hearing, he expressed his difficulties to continue in service due to poor health condition and family circumstances and proposed to retire from service on personal grounds.

And whereas, Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, had absconded duty all of a sudden on 03-02-2017 without applying for leave or making any sort of intimation to the leave sanctioning authority/appointing authority. From 03-02-2017, Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, is on unauthorized absence deserting the post. The act of the Government servant is grave 'negligence of duty'. This grave misconduct of the Government servant, leading to desertion of the post, making it in-operational for a long period and thereby hampering the administrative works to be carried out in the official sector, is unwarranted and clearly unbecoming of a Government servant.

And whereas, Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, while in service is reported to be on unauthorized absence from duty on several occasions from the year 2000 *i.e.*, after being promoted as Upper Division Clerk. Periodical unauthorized absences followed by attending of duty for a small spell of days are found to be recurring activities of the Government servant.

Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, has often resorted to absconding of duty by unauthorized absence. In particular, during the last 10 years of service (*i.e.*, from January 2008) Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, has been on unauthorized absence from duty for a total period of more than 7 years in various spells. Despite several warnings issued to Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, has never corrected his attitude of negligence to duty at any point of his service. This attitude of violation of the rules and norms set forth to govern the service, by the individual, is highly condemnable and lowers the moral of the person. This attitude of grave negligence to duty pictures the character of Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, to be unfit for Government service.

And whereas, Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, has been corresponded on various occasion *vide* Memoranda, dated 27-03-2017 and 24-11-2017 with directions to report for duty. Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, neither reported for duty nor replied to any of the above correspondences and thereby, exhibited wilful insubordination or disobedience, to the lawful and reasonable orders of his superior. These activities of the Government servant are highly unwarranted. This clearly reveals his 'insubordination' to departmental authorities, grave 'negligence of duty' and complete defiance of 'fundamental rules/conduct rules' and thereby, exhibits his character to become unfit for Government service. These are the evident factors for unbecoming of a Government servant.

And whereas, Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, during the hearing on 16-07-2018 articulated his apology towards the inconvenience caused through unauthorized absence. He also expressed the inability to continue in service due to poor health condition and family circumstances and pleaded for admitting him into voluntary retirement. Subsequently, *vide* Representation/Notice, dated 18-07-2018 for voluntary

retirement from service by Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk. Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, tendered his notice for voluntary retirement from service on 18-07-2018 with a plea to admit his voluntary retirement on personal grounds on the same day by exempting the notice period. This obviously reveals that Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, is well aware of the fact that he has nothing to represent, as the charges levelled are true based on facts and stands proved by virtue of the documents, such as, Memoranda, dated 27-03-2017 and 24-11-2017, charge-sheet, dated 02-07-2018 and Acknowledgment, dated 04-07-2018 of the Postal Department.

And whereas, Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, is on unauthorized absence from duty from 03-02-2017 to till date. The case of Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, befits for imposing major penalty of "compulsory retirement" under the provisions of rule - 11 (vii) of the CCS (CCA) Rules, 1965. However, in consideration of the past services of Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, and to sustain good faith in the principles of natural justice, the plea of Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, to admit into voluntary retirement on personal grounds is viewed to be tenable.

Now, therefore, the undersigned in exercise of the powers conferred under rule 12 of the Central Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1965, hereby declares that the request made by Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, for voluntary retirement on personal grounds is acceded. As the individual is already on EOL, the notice period for voluntary retirement is hereby exempted as per the guidelines issued in Government of India Decision-2 (G.I., Department of Per. and Trg., O.M. No.25013/3/2003-Estt.(A), dated 17-06-2003) under rule-32 of the CCS (Leave) Rules, 1972. Thiru E. Kings Berry Larson Raja, Upper Division Clerk, is admitted into voluntary retirement from service on the afternoon of 18-07-2018. The period of unauthorized absence from 03-02-2017 to 18-07-2018 shall be treated as EOL without medical certificate and period of absence shall not count for qualifying service to pension.

 - Stage-III . . High jump – 1.20 mts.
 - Stage-IV . . 100 meters run – 15.00 seconds.

*Ex-servicemen will be not required to pass physical efficiency test. They will be eligible to appear for the written test if, they possess the minimum physical measurements and pass the medical examination.

- (b) For female candidates
 - Stage-I . . 200 mts. run – 45 seconds.
 - Stage-II . . Long jump – 2.75 mts.
 - Stage-III . . High jump – 0.9 mts.

Note: (1) All the above events are compulsory.
