NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F.5/4/65-GP., dated 11th January, 1965 of the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India, New Delhi and in supersession of the Health, Electricity and Works Department's notification issued in G.O. Ms. No. 7/83-Pt., dated 12th January, 1983 and published in the Supplement to the Official Gazette No. 6, of the 8th February, 1983, save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry, hereby makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'A' post of "Director (Ports)" in the Port Department, Puducherry, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (i) These rules may be called the Government of Puducherry, Port Department, Group 'A' post of "Director (Ports)", Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(ii) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. *Number of post, its classification and Pay Level in the Pay Matrix.*— The number of the said post, its classification and Pay Level in the Pay Matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Method of recruitment, age-limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said post, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualification.*— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person, having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where, the Lieutenant-Governor of Puducherry is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Savings.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxations in upper age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

- Note :* (1) Qualifications are relaxable at the discretion of Union Public Service Commission for reasons to be recorded in writing, in the case of candidates otherwise well qualified.
- Note :* (2) The qualification(s) regarding experience is relaxable at the discretion of the Union Public Service Commission for reasons to be recorded in writing in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes if, at any stage of selection, the Union Public Service Commission is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these Communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the vacancies reserved for them.

Note 1 : Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other Organization/Department of the Central Governments shall ordinarily not exceed 4 years. The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

13. Circumstances in which the Union Public Service Commission is to be consulted in making recruitment. : Consultation with Union Public Service Commission is necessary for filling up of post.
