Whereas, it has been submitted by the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry that you are involving in various offences against public tranquility, offences affecting property and offences affecting human body and that you have become a perennial source of threat to the community, public peace and order;

And whereas, the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry, submitted that on 14-10-2019 around 09.15 hours while the petitioner was performing rounds in Ariyankuppam Police Station limit received a reliable information about the proceeding of Veerampattinam fishermen towards Nallavadu, likewise another such mob from Nallavadu is proceeding towards Veerampattinam as a result of pending dispute between the two villages.

And whereas, it is further, stated by the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry that around 09.30 hrs at the sea shore of Puthukuppam fishermen village on the northern side of Paradise Beach, the petitioner found about 200 Veerampattinam fishermen villagers with dangerous weapons like

sulikki and iron rods, headed by (1) Viswanathan, (2) Padmanaban, (3) Baskar, (4) Deivabalan, (5) Kalivarathan, (6) Chandiran and (7) Kulla Sakthivel. Similarly, on the southern side the petitioner found about 200 fishermen of Nallavadu fishermen village with deadly weapons like sulikki and iron rods headed by (1) Sathiyamoorthy @ Vetri, son of Sivalingam, (2) Rajesh, son of Subramani, (3) Saleem, son of Arivazhagan, (4) Marlan, son of Puththupattan, (5) Velumani, son of Ramachandiran, (6) Iyyappan, son of Dhanabal, (7) Manjni, son of Govindu, (8) Ravi @ Ravichandiran, son of Perumal and about hundred of villagers in sea on their boats.

And whereas, I am convinced of your involvement in the criminal cases filed as follows : Cr. No. 73/2019, under section 436 IPC, r/w 34 IPC of Thavalakuppam Police Station, Cr. No. 80/2019 under sections 147, 148, 153(a) IPC, r/w 149 IPC and 27 (1)(a) of Arms Act of Thavalakuppam Police Station. Based on the same incident two more cases were registered in Cr. No. 81/2019 under sections 147, 148, 324, 307, 427 IPC, r/w 34 IPC and 27(1)(a) of Arms Act on the complaint of Surendar (21), son of Sivakumar, No. 53, North Mettu Street, Veerampattinam, Puducherry and Cr. No. 82/2019 under sections 147, 148, 324, 307, 427 IPC, r/w 34 IPC and 27(1)(a) of Arms Act on the complaint of Iyyappan @ Iyyanarappan (36), son of Dhanabal, No. 06, South Street, Nallavadu, Puducherry.

And whereas, it is evident from the above cases that you have involved in committing serious offences which would endanger the life of innocent public and their peace and order. Your vengeful acts along with your accomplices against your opponents have created panic in the minds of the people;

And whereas, the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, has filed a case against you *vide* I.R. No. 88/2019 under section 144 of Cr. P.C., dated 17-10-2019. It is stated by the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station that you using money and muscle power to evade the process of law and indulging in crime such as rioting, hurt, assault, obstructions, annoyance, damages to public and private properties and disturbance to the public tranquility and order, and you have created panic in the minds of local inhabitants. It is also stated that you have become a source of terror among the public;

And, whereas, it is also stated in the IR that the Station House Officer has received reliable information that you are involving in various offences by using sulikki and iron rods to attack the victims. You also violated the conditions imposed by the Criminal Courts and have scant respect to the Judiciary and rule of law and also earned displeasure among a section of other rowdy group in the area on account of the grudge against you and hence, rival group is also waiting for opportunity to take revenge upon you;

And whereas, the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, further submitted that if, you are allowed to reside in Ariyankuppam Police Station limits, it is apprehended that you would continue to indulge in serious offences like assault, obstructions, annoyance, *etc.*, and thereby emerged as a perennial source of threat to the community and disturb public peace and order. Hence, the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, has prayed to invoke

provisions under section 144 Cr.P.C. against you not to enter into the jurisdiction of the Ariyankuppam Police Station limit for a period of two months as to prevent danger to the human life and properties and disturbance to the public tranquility and order;

And whereas, based on the report laid before me, I am of the opinion that if, you are allowed to reside within the limits of my jurisdiction, you will continue to indulge in and also motivate serious offences like hurt, assault, damages to public and private properties, obstructions, annoyance, *etc.*, and thereby become a perennial source of threat to the community and disturb public peace and order. Such situations cannot be handled effectively by taking recourse to usual procedures contemplated by law and hence, it is necessary that special provision under section 144 of Cr.P.C., is invoked to take action against you to prevent harm to life and properties of citizens and uphold public peace and order;

And whereas, I am satisfied that you are an habitual offender, wherein, it necessitates to maintain law and order and the given time constraint, serving of notice to you as provided under the code could not be followed and that your activities will endanger human life and properties and your presence is a threat to public tranquility in my Subdivision. Therefore, an immediate action is required for curtailing your illegal activities in the locality;

And whereas, in the view of urgency of matter, this is *ex parte*;

Now, therefore, based on the reasons stated above, I, T. Sudhakar, Subdivisional Magistrate (North), Puducherry, in exercise of powers conferred under Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 do hereby prohibit you under section 144 (2) of Cr.P.C. from entering into the region under the jurisdiction of the Ariyankuppam Police Station limit for a period of two months from the date of this Order or till any further, orders are passed by the Competent Authority revoking this prohibition as per law, whichever is earlier except when you are summoned to attend the cases in any of the Courts in Puducherry. However, you may appear either in person or by Pleader before the undersigned to represent against this order.
