And whereas, the Station House Officer, Dhanvantri Nagar Police Station, Puducherry, further submitted that if, you are allowed to reside in Dhanvantri Nagar limits, it is apprehended that you would continue to indulge in serious offences like murder, extortion, damages to public and private properities, assault, obstructions, annoyance, etc., and thereby emerged as a perennial source of threat to the community and disturb public peace and order.
