NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the use of Aadhaar, as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity.

2. And whereas, the Department of Women and Child Development, Puducherry (hereinafter, referred to as the Department/Implementing Agency), notified the following State Schemes (hereinafter, referred to as the Schemes), as amended from time to time.

- 1. Puducherry Old Age Persons and Destitutes Pension Scheme.
- 2. Grant of Financial Assistance to HIV/AIDS affected people.
- 3. Puducherry Free Supply of Clothing Items to the poor people.
- 4. Grant of financial assistance for performance of marriage of poor Brides living below poverty line in the Union territory of Puducherry
- 5. Grant of Marriage Allowance towards marriage of Daughters of Destitute Widows.
- 6. Incentive for Widow's Remarriage.
- 7. Grant of Financial Assistance to Poor Parents having only one Girl Child who is studying in 8th to 10th Standard
- 8. Grant of incentive to the family having one girl child/two girl children and parents who have undergone family planning in the Union territory of Puducherry
- 3. And whereas, under the aforesaid Schemes, the benefits are extended to eligible beneficiaries by the Implementing Agency as per the extant norms/fund availability;
- 4. And whereas, the aforesaid Schemes involves recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of Union territory of Puducherry/the Consolidated Fund of India.

- 5. Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Lieutenant-Governor, Puducherry, hereby notifies the following, namely:—
- (i) An individual, eligible for receiving the benefits under the aforesaid Schemes shall hereby be required to furnish proof of possession of the Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
- (ii) Any individual desirous of availing the benefits under the aforesaid Schemes, who does not possess the Aadhaar Number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment before registering for the Scheme.
- (iii) Provided that he/she is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per the section 3 of the said Act, and such individuals shall visit any Aadhaar Enrolment Centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website www.uidai.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.
- (iv) As per Regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Department is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar Enrolment Centre located in the respective areas of said beneficiaries in the Union territory of Puducherry, the Department shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the individual, benefits under the rules shall be given to such individual, subject to the production of the following documents, namely:—

- (a) If, he/she has enrolled his/her Aadhaar Enrolment Identification slip; and
 - (b) Any one of the following documents, namely:—
 - (i) Bank or Post Office Passbook with photo; or
 - (ii) Permanent Account Number (PAN) Card; or
 - (iii) Passport; or
 - (iv) Family Ration Card; or

- (v) Voter's Identity Card; or
- (vi) MGNREGA Card; or
- (vii) Kisan Photo Passbook; or
- (viii) Driving licence issued by the Licensing Authority under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988); or
 - (ix) Certificate of identity having photo of such person issued by a Gazetted Officer or a Tahsildar on an official letter head; or
 - (x) Any other document as specified by the Department:

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an Officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

- 6. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Schemes conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.
- 7. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor bio-metrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely:-
- (a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with finger-print authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;
- (b) in case the bio-metric authentication through finger-prints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One-Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;
- (c) in all other cases, where biometric or Aadhaar One-Time Password or Time-Based One-Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the rules may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response (QR) Code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of QR Code reader shall be provided at the convenient . locations by the Department through its Implementing Agency.

- 8. In addition to the above, in order to ensure that no *bona fide* beneficiary under the Scheme is deprived of his/her due benefits, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall follow the exception handling mechanism as outlined in the Office Memorandum of DBT Mission, Cabinet Secretariat, Government of India, dated 19th December, 2017.
- 9. This notification shall come into effect from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette of Puducherry.
