ORDER

Whereas, under sub-section (1) of section 25 of the Puducherry Hindu Religious Institutions Act, 1972 sanction has been accorded by the then Commissioner, Hindu Religious Institutions, Puducherry, to the Board of Trustees of Sri Subramaniarswamy, Sri Nagamuthu Mariamman Devasthanam, Saram, Puducherry, for the alienation of land comprised in R.S.No. 217/6 of Saram Revenue Village to an extent of 0.37.00 HAC in favour of the Electricity Department, Puducherry, for the establishment of 110/22 KV Lawspet Sub-Station. Accordingly, a document was registered *vide* 523/2012 of Book 1, dated 9th February, 2012;

Whereas, the Board of Trustees of Arulmigu Sivasubramaniarswamy, Sri Arulmigu Balamuthu Mariamman Devasthanam, Lawspet, had submitted a French Document *vide* RV 107 Vo1.No. 75/1921 alongwith the Tamil translation and Land-tax Receipts issued by the Taluk Office, Puducherry and the receipts for leasing out the tenant and claimed the right over the property in R.S.No. 217/6 correlating to Cadastre No. 390 and 409 of Oulgaret Commune, Saram Veli *i.e.*, the schedule mentioned property in the French Document;

And whereas, now, it has been ascertained from the above documents and records submitted by Arulmigu Sivasubramaniarswamy, Sri Arulmigu Balamuthu Mariamman Devasthanam, Lawspet, that the land bearing R.S.No. 217/6 of Saram Revenue Village belongs to them and they established the ownership right over the property mentioned above. As such, the document, registered *vide* 523/2012 of Book 1, dated 9th February, 2012, to be corrected;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under sub-section (1) of section 25 of Puducherry Hindu Religious Institutions Act, 1972 on the undersigned being the Commissioner for the purpose of the said Act, sanction is hereby accorded to the said temple authorities of the abovesaid Devasthanam for the alienation of land comprised in R.S.No. 217/6 of Saram Revenue Village (as per French Document Cad. No. 390 and 409 of Saram Veli) in Puducherry region, to an extent of 00H-37 A-00Ca. in favour of the Electricity Department, Puducherry, for the establishment of 110/22 KV Lawspet Sub-Station on the said temple land @ ₹ 700 per sq.ft (the GLR 2010-2011).

Further, it is ordered that:

(a) The sale proceeds with interest now in the name of Sri Subramaniarswamy, Sri Nagamuthu Mariamman Devasthanam, Saram, Puducherry, as FDR to be remitted into a Nationalized Bank and should be converted as Fixed Deposit in favour of "The Commissioner, Hindu Religious Institutions on Account of Arulmigu Sivasubramaniarswamy, Sri Arulmigu Balamuthu Mariamman Devasthanam, Lawspet", with the permission of the undersigned.

(b) The Fixed Deposit shall not be withdrawn from the Bank on any account and shall be reinvested again and again perpetuating the asset.

(c) The transaction shall be completed within the period of three months from the date of this Order. The progress report on the alienation of the temple land shall be sent to the office of the undersigned every month without fail, till the completion of this alienation.

Terms of Reference(ToR) of Empowered Group of Secretaries (EGoS)

- (i) Review and monitor implementation of the Plan to ascertain the logistics efficiency accruing thereof;
- (ii) Adopt framework and norms for undertaking any amendments in the Plan;
- (iii) Coordinate for any changes in the projects already included in the Plan, within the prescribed framework and norms;
- (iv) To set out a procedure and a definitive timeframe for synchronization of various activities for construction of roads, rail, *etc.*, along with all utility services in an area-based approach for the development of infrastructure on a pilot basis;

(v) Align various initiatives on the development of a Common Integrated Portal that serves the needs of all stakeholders;

(vi) Issue appropriate directions for achieving the objectives and for compliance to guiding Principles of the Master Plan and in addressing demand-side requirements of concerned Departments.

Objectives

The PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan for Multi-modal Infrastructure Connectivity to the Economic Zones is an Integrated Plan depicting the Economic Zones and the Multi-modal Connectivity Infrastructure with an objective to holistically integrate the interventions of various State Government Departments and address missing gaps to ensure seamless movement of people, goods and services, minimizing disruptions, ensuring quick completion of works with cost efficiency. In this context, the Institutional setup in the Union territory of Puducherry in line with the Constitutional frame work in Government of India shall be as follows:

2. The Technical Support Unit (TSU) shall be constituted by nominating a Departmental official by each Member of the Network Planning Group for supporting and identifying the Department level planning activities.

The Terms of Reference (ToR), Scope of Work of Network Planning Group (NPG)

1. The group will be responsible for sharing their specific Action Plans for 2020-21 to 2024-25 with each other for facilitating the integration of networks, enhancing optimization through modification/expansion/new network creation to avoid duplication of works for holistic development of any region as well as reducing logistics costs through micro-plan detailing.

2. This group shall after examining all the interventions proposed to be taken by various Departments/Ministries will delineate all projects where synchronization of efforts are required and propose any changes in the State Master Plan for consideration and approval of the EGoS.

3. The Network Planning Group will also examine the following proposals which are not forming part of the Master Plan currently;

- (i) Projects of Infrastructure Connectivity which

are costing more than 500 crores included under Multi-modal Infrastructure classification where DPRs have either been completed or in an advanced stage;

(ii) All major new connectivity/network proposals of Infrastructure Connectivity involving the cost of more than ₹ 500 crores or those that are vital or critical from a multi-modal connectivity point of view to be so determined by the Logistics Division/NPG;

(iii) Further, NPG may also recommend Critical Multi-modal Connectivity project proposals to ensure proper integration and may also examine projects with reference to Tourism Development.

4. The Nodal Officers of the concerned Departments will be responsible to ensure that the data inputs of the progress pertaining to the respective Department have been correctly mapped in the SMP through the individual applications provided by BISAG-N.

5. In order to avoid duplication of procurement and processing of the high- resolution satellite images from the National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC), one of the Primary Centres of Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO), Department of Space (DoS), BISAG-N will be the sole agency to procure this for the platform (PM Gati Shakti NMP) and would be facilitated by the Logistics Division.

6. Geospatial data of each stakeholder using this platform will be developed on these images.

7. This portal will provide a consolidated view and enable review of all projects through a dashboard and Project management module of various organizations.

8. It is through this GIS platform-based system, NPG will monitor all the interventions in the Master Plan and prepare periodic reports for review by the EGoS on the implementation.

9. Will assist EGoS in coordinating any changes in the projects already included in the Master Plan. While close coordination with the Private Sector Industries, experts will also be closely associated and consulted during planning and implementation.

10. The Members of NPG shall meet quarterly in a financial year or as the need arises.
