**to authorise payment and appropriation of certain
sums from and out of the Consolidated
Fund of the Union territory of Puducherry
for the services in respect of the Financial
Year 2024-2025.**

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of
Puducherry in the Seventy-fifth Year of the Republic
of India as follows :—

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation
(No. II) Act, 2024.

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund
of the Union territory of Puducherry, there may
be paid and applied sums not exceeding those
specified in column (5) of the schedule, amounting
in the aggregate [inclusive of the sums specified
in column (3) of the schedule to the Puducherry
Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2024] to
the sum of Twelve thousand seven hundred crore
rupees, towards defraying the several charges
which will come in the course of payment during
the Financial Year from 2024-2025 in respect of
the services specified in column (2) of the schedule.
