This petition along with Case Sheet is filed by the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry, praying to pass orders under section 144 of Cr.P.C., against the Counter Petitioner to prevent imminent danger to human lives and properties, and disturbance to the public tranquility and order, in the jurisdiction of this Court.

2. The Counter Petitioner is Thiru Pravin @ Pravin Kumar @ Puramandai (19), son of Ravikumar, a resident of No. 12, Old Pooranankuppam Street, Ariyankuppam, Puducherry.

3. *The facts which led up to the petition are briefly as follows:* The case submitted by the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry, through the Superintendent of Police (South), Puducherry *vide* I.R. No. 10/2024 under section 144 of Cr.P.C., dated 20-01-2024. Therein, it has been stated that the Counter Petitioner have formed a gang of rowdies and bent upon indulging in crime such as extortion, hurt. The Counter Petitioner has created panic in the minds of local inhabitants. As a result the people of the locality being afraid of the Counter Petitioner do not come forward to lodge any complaint against him. It is also stated that even witnesses don't come forward voluntarily to give evidence against him in the cases where he is the accused. In this connection, the Petitioner has stated that the following criminal cases were registered against the Counter Petitioner

1. Cr. No. 172/2023 under sections 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) IPC r/w 34 IPC of Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry – Under Investigation.
2. Cr. No. 178/2023 under sections 294(b), 341, 323, 324, 506(ii) IPC r/w 34 IPC of Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry – Under Investigation.
3. Cr. No. 85/2023 under sections 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) IPC r/w 34 IPC of Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry – Under Investigation.
4. Cr. No. 143/2019 under sections 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) IPC r/w 34 IPC of Reddiyarpalayam Police Station, Puducherry – Pending Trial.

4. The Petitioner further submitted that the Counter Petitioner is a notorious rowdy element. It is also stated that he is not having any job of his own but he is leading a lavish life with the money earned through extortion. It is further stated that the Counter Petitioner is not a law abiding person and he has involved in various offences by using deadly weapons, *i.e.*, aruval and knife to attack victims. He uses money and muscle power to evade the process of law. Further, stated that he violated the conditions imposed by the criminal Courts and has scant respect to the judiciary and rule of Law.

5. It is also stated in the I.R. that the Station House Officer have received reliable information that the Counter Petitioner earned displeasure among a section of other rowdy group in the area on account of the grudge against him and hence, rival group is also waiting opportunity to take revenge upon him.

6. The Petitioner further submitted that if, the Counter Petitioner is allowed to reside in Ariyankuppam limits, it is apprehended that he would continue to indulge in serious offences like murder, extortion, damages to public and private properties, assault, obstructions, annoyance, *etc.*, and thereby emerged as a perennial source of threat to the community and disturb public peace and order.

Hence, the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry, has prayed to invoke provisions under section 144 of Cr. P.C., against the Counter Petitioner do not to enter into the jurisdiction of this Court for a period of two months as to prevent danger to the human life and properties and disturbance to the public tranquility and order.

7. The proceeding was started by affording an opportunity to the Counter Petitioner to show cause against the petition filed by the Petitioner. A notice was served to both the parties on 08-04-2024 to appear for the hearing on 12-04-2024 at 10.00 a.m. It was instructed to serve the notice to the Counter Petitioner through the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry. The notice was received by the Counter Petitioner.

8. On 12-04-2024, the Station House Officer, Ariyankuppam Police Station, Puducherry, and the Counter Petitioner were present.

9. I have heard both the sides and carefully gone through all the available records in file placed by the Petitioner. In the Police Information Report/Petition, it is stated that the activities of the Counter Petitioner is in such a manner that he may cause breach of peace and create a problem of law and order and public tranquility. He has involved in crimes such as murder, hurt and disturbance to the public peace and order. There are 4 criminal cases were registered against him in various Police Stations. I have also heard the oral submissions of the Counter Petitioner. The Counter Petitioner has stated that the Petitioner has filed this false case with an ulterior motive.

10. Upon hearing both sides and on perusal of the records submitted by the Petitioner, I am of the opinion that if, the Counter Petitioner is allowed to reside within the limits of my jurisdiction, the Counter Petitioner will continue to indulge in and also motivate serious offences like murder, hurt, extortion, damages to public and private properties, assault, obstructions, annoyance, *etc.*, and thereby become a perennial source of threat to the community and disturb public peace and order. Such situations cannot be handled effectively by taking recourse to usual procedures contemplated by law and hence, it is necessary that special provision under section 144 of Cr.P.C., is invoked to take action against the Counter Petitioner to prevent harm to life and properties of citizens and uphold public peace and order.

11. Hence, I, Arjun Ramakrishnan, do hereby in the capacity of Subdivisional Magistrate (North), Puducherry, in exercise of powers conferred under the section 144(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, pass this order and prohibit the Counter Petitioner Thiru Pravin @ Pravin Kumar @ Puramandai (19), son of Ravikumar, a resident of No. 12, Old Pooranankuppam Street, Ariyankuppam, Puducherry, from entering into the region under the jurisdiction of the Subdivisional Magistrate Court (North) until 20-04-2024 from the date of this order (in view of the GELS-2024) or till any further orders are passed by the Competent Authority revoking this prohibition as per law, whichever is earlier except when you are summoned to attend the cases in any of the Courts in Puducherry.

As a result the people of the locality being afraid of the Counter Petitioner do not come forward to lodge any complaint against him. It is also stated that even witnesses don't come forward voluntarily to give evidence against him in the cases where he is the accused. Therein, it has been stated that the Counter Petitioner have indulging in crime such as murder, kidnapping, hurt and disturbance to the public tranquility and order. The Counter Petitioner has created panic in the minds of local inhabitants. It is also stated that he is leading lavish life with the money earned through extortion. As a result the people of the locality being afraid of the Counter Petitioner do not come forward to lodge any complaint against him. It is also stated that even witnesses don't come forward voluntarily to give evidence against him in the cases where he is the accused. In this connection, the Petitioner has stated that the following criminal cases were registered against the Counter Petitioner.

1. Cr. No. 69/2019 under sections 148, 307 IPC r/w 149 IPC r/w 34 IPC, dated 24-08-2019 of Mettupalayam Police Station, Puducherry.
2. Cr. No. 155/2020 under sections 148, 302, 120-B IPC r/w 149 IPC, dated 14-10-2020 of Mettupalayam Police Station, Puducherry.

4. The Petitioner further submitted that the Counter Petitioner was very active notorious rowdy element and become a source of terror among the public. It is also stated that he is not a law abiding citizen and he has involved in various offences by using aruval, knife to attack the victims and scant respect to the judiciary and rule of Law.

5. The Petitioner further submitted that if, the Counter Petitioner is allowed to reside in Puducherry north limits, it is apprehended that he would continue to indulge in serious offences like murder, assault, extortion, obstructions, annoyance, damages to public and private properties, *etc.*, and thereby emerged as a perennial source of threat to the community and disturb public peace and Order. Hence, the Station House Officer, Mettupalayam Police Station, Puducherry, has prayed to invoke provisions under section 144 Cr.P.C., against the Counter Petitioner to not to enter into the jurisdiction of this Court for a period of two months as to prevent danger to the human life and properties of citizens and uphold public peace and order.

6. The proceeding was started by affording an opportunity to the Counter Petitioner to show cause against the petition filed by the Petitioner. A notice was served to both the parties on 12-04-2024 to appear for the hearing on 15-04-2024. It was instructed to serve the notice to the Counter Petitioner through the Station House Officer, Mettupalayam Police Station, Puducherry. The notice for the Counter Petitioner was received by his mother, Jabarani. The service was held sufficient for the Counter Petitioner.

7. On 15-04-2024, the Station House Officer, Mettupalayam Police Station, Puducherry was present. The Counter Petitioner has failed to appear before the Court on hearing date.

8. I have heard the Petitioner and carefully gone through all the available records placed before me. In the Police Information Report/Petition, it is stated that the activities of Thiru Joseph is in such a manner that he may cause breach of peace and create a problem of law and order and public tranquility. He has involved in crimes such as murder, assault, unlawful activities and disturbance to the public peace and order. There are two criminal cases were registered against him in Mettupalayam Police Station, Puducherry.

9. On perusal of the records submitted by the Petitioner and the recommendation of the Superintendent of Police (North), I am of the opinion that if, the Counter Petitioner is allowed to reside within the limits of my jurisdiction, the Counter Petitioner will continue to indulge in and also motivate serious offences like murder, assault, extortion, obstructions, annoyance, damages to public and private properties, *etc.*, and thereby emerged as a perennial source of threat to the community and disturb public peace and Order. Such situations cannot be handled effectively by taking recourse to usual procedures contemplated by law and hence, it is necessary that special provision under section 144 of Cr.P.C. is invoked to take action against the Counter Petitioner to prevent harm to life and properties of citizens and uphold public peace and order.

10. Hence, I, Arjun Ramakrishnan, do hereby in the capacity of Subdivisional Magistrate (North), Puducherry, in exercise of powers conferred under the section 144(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, pass this order and prohibit the Counter Petitioner Thiru Joseph (22), son of Karunakaran, a resident of No. 10, Gandhi Street, Gandhi Thirunalloor, Muthirayarpalayam, Puducherry, from entering into the region under the jurisdiction of the Subdivisional Magistrate Court (North) until 20-04-2024 from the date of this order (in view of the GELS-2024) or till any further, orders are passed by the Competent Authority revoking this prohibition as per law, whichever is earlier except when you are summoned to attend the cases in any of the Courts in Puducherry. However, you may represent against this order before the undersigned by post or by Counsel.
