GOVERNMENT OF PUDUCHERRY DIRECTORATE OF SPORTS AND YOUTH AFFAIRS (SECRETARIAT WING)

(G.O. Ms. No. 02, Puducherry, dated 04th October 2024)

ORDER

The Government of Puducherry constituted a High Level Committee headed by the Chief Secretary to the Government of Puducherry *vide* G.O. Ms. No. 65, dated 23-02-2024 of the Directorate of Sports and Youth Affairs, Puducherry, to frame detailed Guidelines and Modalities for implementation of 5% horizontal reservation for Meritorious Sports Persons (MSPs) in the recruitment for the Group 'C' posts in Government Departments of the Union territory of Puducherry.

- 2. The High Level Committee after detailed deliberations evolved and recommended the Guidelines and Modalities to be adopted in selection of Meritorious Sports Persons for appointment against Direct Recruitment quota of various Group 'C' Posts in Government Departments of the Union territory of Puducherry under the Sports Quota, as well as prescribed the Eligibility Criteria for Sports Achievement(s) at various level(s).
- 3. The Government after careful consideration of the recommendations of the High Level Committee Orders that, -
- (i) The Sports achievement eligible for the MSP quota earmarked for direct recruitment in Group 'C' Posts of various Departments of the Union territory of Puducherry, shall be as prescribed in the Annexure to this Order;
- (ii) The Directorate of Sports and Youth Affairs, Government of Puducherry shall be coopted in the selection process for scrutiny of applications of Meritorious Sports Persons in the respective recruitment processes;
- (iii) The Criteria for preparing the merit list by the Selection Committee and other criteria relating to appointment of the eligible Sportspersons would be as prescribed in the Annexure to this Order.
- (iv) All the Government Departments in the Government of Puducherry shall scrupulously follow these Guidelines for appointment under Sports Quota in all future recruitments to Group 'C' posts in the Union territory of Puducherry.

ANNEXURE

GUIDELINES AND MODALITIES TO BE ADOPTED IN THE SELECTION OF MERITORIOUS SPORTS PERSONS (MSPs) UNDER SPORTS QUOTA FOR APPOINTMENT THROUGH DIRECT RECRUITMENT TO GROUP 'C' POSTS IN VARIOUS GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS OF THE UNION TERRITORY OF PUDUCHERRY, INCLUDING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA PRESCRIBED FOR VARIOUS LEVEL SPORTS ACHIEVEMENTS

- (I) Short title, extent and commencement.— (i) The Guidelines shall be called the "Guidelines and Modalities for direct recruitment of Meritorious Sportsperson in Group "C" Posts in various Departments of the Government of Puducherry".
- (ii) The Guidelines extend to the whole of the Union territory of Puducherry.
- (iii) It shall come into force on and from the date of its notification in the Official Gazette of the Union territory of Puducherry.
- (II) Object.— (i) To specify the Methodology of appointment, criteria and provisions for the implementation of the 5% horizontal reservation earmarked for Meritorious Sportspersons in Direct recruitment to Group "C" Posts (Sports Quota) in various Government Departments of the Union territory of Puducherry.
- (ii) To recognise the achievement of Meritorious Sportspersons, securing Gold/ Silver/Bronze Medal or First/Second/Third position or, participation in recognized International/National Level Games/ Championships and to encourage them in the field of Sports.
- (III) Eligibility.— (a) Appointments of sportspersons considered meritorious can be made with reference to the following criteria under these orders:
- (i) The Sportspersons, who are residents of the Union territory of Puducherry, shall only be eligible for appointment under the sports quota earmarked in direct recruitment for filling up the vacancies in various group 'C' Posts in the Union territory of Puducherry.

(ii) Sportspersons who have represented a State or the Country in the National or International competition; or Medal winners in Senior or Junior National Championships; or Medal winners in Khelo India Youth Games (age category above 18 years); or Khelo India Winter Games or Khelo India Para Games; or Medal winners in Khelo India University Games; or Medal winners in School Games Federation of India (SGFI) in any of the games/sports mentioned in these instructions.

For Chess: Grand Master (GM) Title, International Master (IM) Title, Chess Olympiad. IM/GM title should be in Open Category like Woman Grandmaster (WGM) etc., While National Open Chess Championship is treated as 'National Championships', the Medal winning performance in National Team Chess Championship will also be considered for recruitment.

- (iii) Sportspersons who have represented their University in the Inter-University Tournaments conducted by the Inter-University Sports Boards in any of the sports/games specified in these instructions, as amended from time to time.
- (iv) Sportspersons who have represented the State School Teams in the National sports/games for schools conducted by the All India School Games Federation in any of the games/sports mentioned in these instructions.
- (b) No such appointments can be made unless the candidate is, in all respects, eligible for appointment to the post applied for, and in particular, with regard to age, educational or experience qualifications prescribed under the Recruitment Rules applicable to the post, except to the extent to which, relaxations thereof have been permitted in respect of the class/category of persons to which the applicant belongs.

- (VI) Order of preference.— (a) First preference to those Sportsperson who have represented the country in an International Competition (Tournament) with the clearance of the Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India.
- (b) Next preference may be given to those who have represented a State/Union Territory in the Senior or Junior Level National Championships organized by the National Sports Federations recognized by Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports or National Games organized by Indian Olympics Association and have won medals or positions up to 3rd place. Between the Sportsperson participating in Senior and Junior National Championships/Games, the Sportsperson having participated and won Medal in Senior National Championship would be given preference.
- (c) Next preference would be given to those, who have represented a University in an Inter-University competition conducted by Association of Indian Universities/Inter-University Sports Board or Khelo India University Games conducted with authorization of Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India and have won Medals or positions up to 3rd place in finals.
- (d) Next preference would be given to those who have represented a State/Union Territory in Khelo India Youth Games (age category above 18 years) or Khelo India Winter Games or Khelo India Para Games conducted with authorization of Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India and have won Medals or positions up to 3rd place in finals.
- (e) Next preference would be given to those who have represented the State Schools in the National sports/games for Schools conducted by the All India School Games Federation and have won Medals or positions up to 3rd place.
- (f) Next preference would be given to those who represented a State/Union Territory/University/State Schools Teams at the level(s) mentioned in categories (b) to (e) but, could not win a medal or position, in the same order of preference.

(g) In the order of the abovesaid preference, the category of tournaments shall be classified as under:-

(VII) Events of National Importance.— National Championships/ Tournaments conducted by the recognized National Sports Federations in individual disciplines, National Games conducted by Indian Olympic Associations and Khelo India University/Khelo India Youth Games/ Khelo India Winter Games/Khelo India Para Games are recognized as events of National importance.

- (VIII) Criteria for Preparing Merit List by the Selection Committee.— The following criteria will be followed by the Selection Committee in the preparation of merit list for Direct Recruitment(s) under Meritorious Sports Persons Quota:-
- (i) Points would be given based on the level of sports achievement as per marking Scheme prescribed below for the best achievement made by the sportsperson in Senior or Junior competitions.
- (ii) In case, the same points are obtained by more than one Sportsperson on the basis of criterion (i) above, the second best achievement during the eligible period will be considered for deciding the *inter se* ranking in the merit list. If, the points obtained on the basis of the second-best achievement are also the same, the next best achievement will be considered and so on up to the date of Recruitment Notification.

- (iii) If, ranks of more than one Sportsperson are the same after criterion (ii) above, the sportsperson who made the best achievement in previous financial year also, would be given priority.
- (iv) If, more than one Sportsperson have equal points after criterion (iii) above, the Sportsperson having earlier date of birth will be given higher ranking in the merit list.
- (v) Sports Certificate of Invitational/Memorial/open (except Chess)/Prize money League/Ranking Competitions/Friendly Matches between Countries will not be considered for award of points.
- (vi) The highest achievement of the candidate in only one Annual Tournament in listed Sports disciplines in a year will be considered for awarding points.
- (vii) There shall be participation of at least 6 Countries for the competition to be considered as an International Competition for merit certificate.
- (ix) Achievements/participation in the international tournaments will be considered only with earlier achievements at National and State level tournaments. Direct participation/selection trials/camps in any International or National tournaments will not be considered for award of points.

(IX) Process Of Drawing Merit Amongst Meritorious Sports Persons.— The selection of Sportspersons for appointment under Meritorious Sports Persons Quota shall be drawn as under:-

- Note 3: No preference would be given for winning more than one medal/position.
- Note 4: In case of any doubt about the status of a tournament, the matter will be decided by the Government of Puducherry and such decision shall be the final.
