The intending tenderers (valid licence holders) may inspect the items at the office of the Deputy Director of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Mahe in all working days from 01-07-2025 to 04-07-2025 during office hours with the permission of the Deputy Director of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare, Mahe.
