ORDER

[UNDER SECTION 163(3) BNSS, 2023]

Whereas, it has been made to appear to me that you have scant respect for the rule of law and orders of this Court and that your activities are prejudicial to the maintenance of public peace and tranquility;

And whereas, the Station House Officer concerned has laid information before this Court *vide* I.R.No. 02/2026 under section 163 BNSS, 2023, stating that you are a habitual offender involved in several criminal cases of grave nature affecting public tranquility, as detailed below:

And whereas, it is further reported that despite execution of bail bond in the last convicted case, you have deliberately failed to appear before this Court in the present proceedings even after due service of summons on 22-01-2026, 29-01-2026 and 05-02-2026, thereby exhibiting willful disobedience to the lawful orders of this Court;

And whereas, the Station House Officer, Mangalam Police Station, Puducherry, has elaborately reported that reliable and credible intelligence inputs reveal that you are actively moving with known associates, frequently assembling at odd hours within Uruvaiyar and surrounding areas, and are nurturing deep-seated enmity with rival groups. It is specifically reported that you have been indulging in intimidating behaviour, issuing threats of dire consequences, and attempting to mobilise support to retaliate violently against rival factions. The Station House Officer has further stated that your movements and presence in the locality have already created panic and fear among the general public and that shopkeepers, residents and passers-by are apprehensive of imminent violent confrontations. It is categorically stated that, owing to your antecedents involving offences of grievous hurt, attempt to murder and homicide, your entry into or continued presence within this jurisdiction is likely to precipitate serious law and order problems, including retaliatory attacks, breach of public peace and disturbance to public tranquility, posing grave danger to human life and property;

And whereas, in view of your continuous non-appearance before this Court despite service of summons, this Court is constrained to proceed *ex parte* under section 163(2) of BNSS, 2023, considering the urgency and gravity of the situation;

And whereas, upon an independent and careful consideration of the entire materials placed on record, including the detailed report and intelligence inputs furnished by the Station House Officer, Mangalam Police Station, Puducherry, the nature and gravity of the previous criminal cases registered against you, your involvement in serious offences affecting human body and public tranquility, your willful non-appearance before this Court despite repeated service of summons, and the prevailing ground realities in the locality, I have arrived at my subjective satisfaction that your presence within the limits of this jurisdiction poses an imminent, real and substantial threat to the maintenance of public peace, tranquility and law and order. I am further satisfied that such threat is of an emergent nature and cannot be effectively prevented or neutralised by resorting to ordinary legal remedies available under the general law;

And whereas, I am of the considered opinion that it is necessary to invoke the special powers conferred under section 163 of BNSS, 2023, to prevent danger to human life, disturbance of public tranquility and to maintain law and order;

Now, therefore, I, A. Kumaran, Subdivisional Magistrate (South), Puducherry, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 163(3) of BNSS, 2023, hereby prohibit you, Thiru Manibharathi (22), son of Ramachandiran, from entering into the Subdivisional Magistrate (South), jurisdiction for a period of two months from the date of this order or until further orders by the Competent Authority, whichever is earlier, except for attending Court proceedings when summoned by any Court in Puducherry.

However, you are at liberty to appear either in person or through Counsel before the undersigned to file your representation, if any, against this order as per law.

Whereas, it has been made to appear before this Court that the Counter Petitioner Thiru Vicky @ Vignesh (22), son of Govindaraj, No. 2, Savithiri Nagar, Uruvaiyarpet, Mangalam, Puducherry, is a person having scant respect for the rule of law and orders of this Court and that his activities are highly prejudicial to the maintenance of public peace, public order and tranquility within the jurisdiction of this Court;

And whereas, the Station House Officer, Mangalam Police Station, Puducherry, has laid information before this Court *vide* I.R. No. 01/2026 under section 163 BNSS, 2023, stating that the Counter Petitioner is a habitual offender involved in serious criminal cases of grave nature, including offences affecting human body, public order and tranquility, and that his continued presence or reentry into the locality poses an imminent threat to life and property;

And whereas, the antecedents of the Counter Petitioner reveal his involvement in the following criminal cases registered at Mangalam Police Station and Villianur Police Station, Puducherry:

And whereas, it is reported in Cr.No. 330/2025 that on 17-09-2025 at about 16.00 hours, at Thattanchavadi Road, Lourdes Nagar, Villianur, Puducherry, the Counter Petitioner along with his associates Vidyasagar, Manibharathi and Dinesh, waylaid one Sounder and brutally hacked him to death with sharp weapons, causing fatal injuries on his face, neck and head and thereafter abandoned the body on the road, thereby creating panic, fear and serious disturbance to public tranquility in the locality;

And whereas, the Counter Petitioner was arrested in connection with the said case and was remanded to Judicial Custody at Central Prison, Kalapet, Puducherry, and it is further reported that he is presently in Judicial Custody under offences including provisions of the Arms Act;

And whereas, during the course of enquiry, it has come to the notice of this Court, based on credible intelligence inputs furnished by the Station House Officer, that if the Counter Petitioner is released on bail or by any other means, there exists a real and imminent likelihood that he would resume his violent activities, indulge in acts of retaliation, criminal intimidation and murder, thereby posing a grave threat to public order and tranquility;

And whereas, it is also reported that due to long-standing enmity between rival groups, the life of the Counter Petitioner himself is under constant threat and his release would likely result in retaliatory violence, chain crimes and breach of peace affecting the general public;

And whereas, summons were duly issued to the Counter Petitioner directing him to appear before this Court on 22-01-2026 and 29-01-2026, but the Counter Petitioner failed to appear on both dates, despite due service, thereby willfully disobeying the lawful orders of this Court and demonstrating total disregard for the judicial process;

And whereas, in view of the repeated non-appearance of the Counter Petitioner, the urgency of the situation, the gravity of the offences involved and the imminent danger to public peace and safety, this Court is constrained to proceed *ex parte* under section 163(2) of BNSS, 2023;

And whereas, upon an independent and careful consideration of the entire materials placed on record, including the Police report, criminal antecedents of the Counter Petitioner, intelligence inputs, nature and gravity of the offences, his willful non-appearance before this Court and the prevailing law and order situation in Uruvaiyar and surrounding areas, I have arrived at my subjective satisfaction that the presence or reentry of the Counter Petitioner within this jurisdiction poses an imminent, real and substantial threat to the maintenance of public peace, tranquility and law and order, and that such threat cannot be effectively prevented by invoking ordinary legal remedies;

Now, therefore, I, A. Kumaran, Subdivisional Magistrate (South), Puducherry, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 163(3) of BNSS, 2023, hereby prohibit you, Vicky @ Vignesh (22), son of Govindaraj, from entering into the Subdivisional Magistrate (South), jurisdiction for a period of two months from the date of this order or until further orders by the Competent Authority, whichever is earlier, except for attending Court proceedings when summoned by any Court in Puducherry.

However, you are at liberty to appear either in person or through Counsel before the undersigned to file your representation, if any, against this order as per law.
