ORDER

(UNDER SECTION 163(3) BNSS, 2023)

Whereas, it has been made to appear to me that you have trivial and scant respect to the judiciary and rule of law and are involved in various offences against public tranquility, offences affecting property and human body and that you have become a perennial source of threat to the community, public peace and order;

And whereas, I am convinced of your involvement in various criminal cases as under–

and your vengeful acts and hatching plans along with your accomplices against your opponents have created panic in the minds of the people;

And whereas, the Station House Officer, Villianur Police Station, Puducherry, has filed a case against you *vide* IR.No. 152/2025 under section 170@163 BNSS, dated 10-12-2025, it is stated by the Station House Officer, Villianur Police Station, Puducherry, that you are indulging in crime such as giving indirect threat to the merchants and entrepreneurs and demanding money by showing muscle power and criminal history. It is stated that you are posing threat to the public tranquility and order and you have created panic in the minds of local inhabitants. Further, it is also stated that you have become a source of terror among the public;

And whereas, the Station House Officer, Villianur Police Station, Puducherry, submitted that if, you are allowed to reside in Subdivisional Magistrate (South) Jurisdiction limits, it is apprehended that you would continue to indulge in serious offences like threatening the public and entrepreneurs, mischief and hurt case, attempt to murder and disturbance to the public tranquility and order, *etc.*, and thereby emerged as a perennial source of threat to the community and disturbance to public peace and order;

And whereas, summon was served for your appearance on 18-12-2025 and 30-12-2025 to file your explanation / objection as to why the Subdivisional Magistrate (South), Villianur, Puducherry should not order to prevent you from entering into the south region under section 163(3) of BNSS.

And whereas, the petitioner appeared before this Court for the first hearing, *i.e.*, on 18-12-2025 during which the petitioner submitted that he is facing death threats from known history-sheeters residing in and around his locality. Considering the said submission, this Court advised the petitioner to maintain a low profile, to lead a peaceful life and specifically to change his attire so as to avoid attracting attention and to prevent any disturbance to public peace and tranquility;

And whereas, during the second hearing, *i.e.*, on 30-12-2025, it was brought to the notice of this Court that the Police officials had arrested the petitioner on the morning of the hearing day during surprise checks/trials conducted within the jurisdiction;

And whereas, upon verification, it was revealed that the petitioner had indeed received death threats and that an FIR has been registered based on the complaint given by the petitioner himself in this regard;

And whereas, it was further noticed that the petitioner failed to comply with the advice given by this Court, inasmuch as the attire of the petitioner remained unchanged despite the clear instructions issued earlier by the Subdivisional Magistrate to avoid provocation and maintain peace;

And whereas, based on the report, laid before me, I am of the opinion that presence of the petitioner within the South Jurisdiction is likely to result in further threat to his life as well as disturbance to public peace and order. Hence, such situations cannot be handled effectively by taking recourse to usual procedures contemplated by law and hence, it is necessary that special provision under section 163 of BNSS is invoked to take action against you to prevent harm to life and properties of citizens and uphold public peace and order. Since, your presence is a threat to public tranquility in Puducherry District and therefore, an immediate action is required for curtailing your illegal activities in the locality;

Now, therefore, based on the reasons stated above I, A. Kumaran, Subdivisional Magistrate (South), Puducherry, in exercise of powers conferred under Code of Criminal Procedure do hereby prohibit you under section 163(3) of BNSS from entering into the Subdivisional Magistrate Court (South) Jurisdiction for two months from the date of this order or till any further orders are passed by the Competent Authority revoking this prohibition as per law, whichever is earlier except when you are summoned to attend the cases in any of the Courts in Puducherry. However, you may appear either in person or by Pleader before the undersigned to represent against the order.
