It is stated that you are posing threat to the public tranquility and order and you have created panic in the minds of local inhabitants.

And whereas, the Station House Officer, Villianur Police Station, Puducherry, submitted that if, you are allowed to reside in Subdivisional Magistrate (South), Jurisdiction limits, it is apprehended that you would continue to indulge in serious offences like threatening the public, mischief and hurt case, attempt to murder and disturbance to the public tranquility and order, *etc.*, and thereby emerged as a perennial source of threat to the community and disturbance to public peace and order;

And whereas, it has been specifically stated that due to the counter petitioner's criminal antecedents and violent background, the general public is under constant fear and is unwilling to come forward to lodge complaints against him, apprehending retaliation and harm to their life and property;

And whereas, summon was served for your appearance on 12-03-2026 to file your explanation / objection as to why the Subdivisional Magistrate (South), Villianur, Puducherry, should not order to prevent you from entering into the south region under section 163(3) of BNSS.

And whereas, the petitioner appeared before this Court, the explanation offered by you is unsatisfactory, devoid of merit and fails to dispel the apprehension of breach of peace, and is therefore rejected;

And whereas, upon careful consideration of the report, your antecedents and the prevailing situation, this Court is satisfied that your continued presence poses a real and imminent threat to public peace, safety of persons and protection of property. Further, this Court is further satisfied that lesser preventive measures would not suffice and that temporary externment from the jurisdiction is necessary to neutralize imminent threat and to restore confidence among the general public;

And whereas, based on the report laid before me, I am of the opinion that presence of the petitioner within the South Jurisdiction is likely to result in further threat to his life as well as disturbance to public peace and order. Hence, such situations cannot be handled effectively by taking recourse to usual procedures contemplated by law and hence, it is necessary that special provision under section 163 of BNSS is invoked to take action against you to prevent harm to life and properties of citizens and uphold public peace and order.

Now, therefore, based on the reasons stated above I, A. Kumaran, Subdivisional Magistrate (South), Puducherry, in exercise of powers conferred under Code of Criminal Procedure, do hereby prohibit you under section 163(3) of BNSS from entering into the Subdivisional Magistrate Court (South), Jurisdiction for two months from the date of this order or till any further orders are passed by the Competent Authority revoking this prohibition as per law, whichever is earlier except when you are summoned to attend the cases in any of the Courts in Puducherry.
